

4-H Western Heritage National Conference & Cowboy Shooting Invitational August 2 - 4, 2016

What's included in the registration fee?

Tuesday: Day 1 of "official" Conference - From check-in to bed-time, you're covered. And it all takes place at the Bass Pro Shops Outdoor Academy. Noon meal, catered by Big Cedar Lodge, is included in the cost of registration. The Period Clothing & Character development evaluation takes place this day; as well as the Western Knowledge Quiz. Judging/evaluation of the period clothing will take place in the air-conditioned Lodge at the Outdoor Academy. The evening meal, prepared by the Mountain Men Rendezvous group, is included. The Bull Riding Exhibition in the arena at the Outdoor Academy is covered.

Wednesday: First round cowboy action shooting -5 stages takes place first thing-at the Outdoor Academy, followed by an afternoon of workshops, demonstrations, seminars, living history interpreters. This is the day 4-H members have the opportunity to also display their knowledge by presenting a Working Demonstration. The registration fee covers the day of educational activities, with no "additional fees" anticipated. The registration fee covers the cost of the noon lunch buffet. After the workshops conclude, an evening at Top of the Rock is planned. Admission to Ancient Ozarks Natural History Museum is included as part of your registration; regular cost is \$12 + tax for Adults, \$5 + tax for Children (4-12). Cost of the golf cart ride through the Lost Canyon Cave and Nature Trail (regularly \$25 – Adult and \$12.50 children) is also part of the registration package. If you run out of time Wednesday evening, the Cave Tour ticket is good for Friday also. You receive a voucher, valued at \$20 toward a meal at one of four different Bass Pro/Big Cedar Lodge restaurant venues:

Thursday: The final 5 stages of shooting competition will be conducted. The noon meal at the range is provided as part of the registration fee. The national awards banquet will take place at the Grandview Lodge Conference Center at Big Cedar Lodge Resort. This \$50+ meal is part of the registration package.

MEALS: Breakfasts are on your own. Wednesday evening meal, you will have a \$20 toward your choice of meal. All other meals are included in the registration.

AMMUNITION: If the 4-H competitor shoots .22 rimfire, 38 special, 45 LC, 12 gauge or 20 gauge, the ammo will be provided. If shoot other calibers, ammo will not be provided.

If you add it all up, I think you will find the registration fee is quite a bargain.
